Toronto, ON ...For one night only, Damien Atkins shares an intimate evening in support of the world’s oldest and largest queer theatre. On March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2010, Damien will perform the smash hit solo that garnered him rave reviews, two **Dora Mavor Moore Awards** (including **Outstanding New Musical**), and a sold-out, held-over run at Buddies In Bad Times Theatre in 2003. *Real Live Girl* returns 7 years later to transform the Buddies’ Chamber into a boudoir of musical delights as the hyper-talented Damien Atkins explores the gay male fascination with all things feminine. Through musical interpretations of songs originally written for women, and the creation of a bevy of characters, Damien charts the journey of his own “inner girl”, and reintroduces the audience to such forgotten hits as “Gonna Wash That Man Right Out of My Hair” and “What Every Girl Should Know.”

A few of Atkins’ many accolades include the **Prism International Prize** for his play *The Good Mother* in 2000, the **Elliot Hayes Award** from the Stratford Festival for **Outstanding New Playwright**, the **Elizabeth Sterling Haynes Award** for **Outstanding Performance** for the Edmonton run of *Miss Chatelaine*. Damien was named as one of **NOW Magazine’s “Top Ten Theatre Artists” of 2001** and one of **MacLean’s Magazine’s “Twenty-Five Young Canadians to Watch” in 2002**. He has appeared in Canadian Stage’s *Sweeney Todd*, *The Glass Menagerie*, *Frost/Nixon* and *7 Stories* and was playwright-in-residence in 2008/2009. For Soulpepper, Damien has played in *The Importance of Being Earnest*, *The Caretaker*, *King Lear* and *The Way of the World*. Damien has appeared in various productions including Crow’s Theatre’s *Unidentified Human Remains*, Neptune Theatre’s *The Retreat From Moscow*, The Dallas Theater Center’s *I Am My Own Wife*, and for the Segal Centre in Montreal: *The Glass*

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*Menagerie* (for which he was nominated for a Masque Award), *Cabaret*, and Mozart in *Amadeus*. Damien's most recent play *Lucy* was nominated for a Dora Award for Outstanding New Play and it played Off Broadway in 2007. Plays by Damien Atkins include: *Henry and Pierre*, *Miss Chatelaine*, *Real Live Girl* and *The Mill: Part Four: Ash*.
